If we double the concentration of CO2 over the next 100 years plants will grow up to 50% faster as shown by this experiment

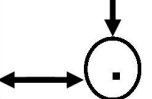
NOT EXACTLY - Of the 2,500 IPCC scientists Only 600 examined the science, of which 308 reviewed the second draft of which 62 considered the cause of climate change of which 7 were independent of which 2 disagreed.so **only 5 independent scientists** said CO2 has a 90% chance of being involved with Climate change.

Compare that with 31,000 scientists Who have signed a petition saying There is NO conclusive evidence CO2 causes climate change

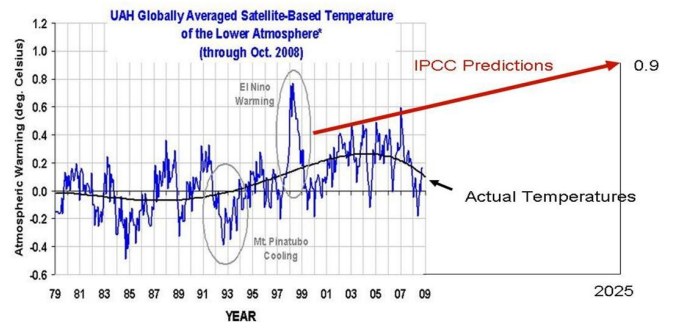
Comparing the 31,000 to the 5

IPCC Predictions versus Actual Temperatures

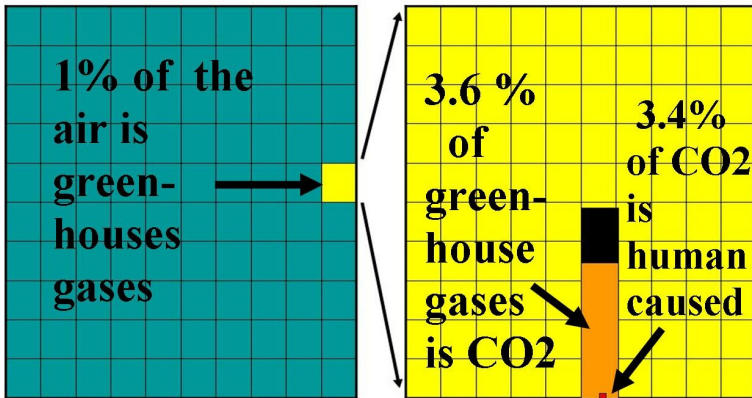

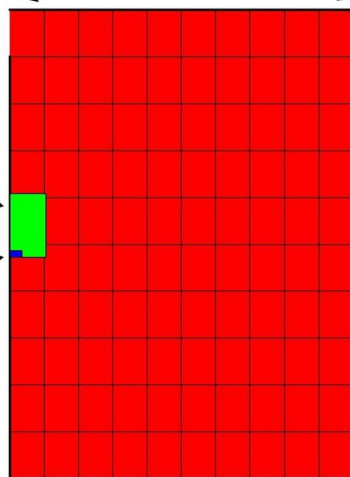

CO2 is a trace Gas



Now zooming in on that small section of Human caused CO2

- 1.5 % is caused by Australia
- The ETS will reduce Australia's CO2 by 5%
- So an ETS in Australia will reduce greenhouse gases by a millionth
- The equivalent of reducing a piece of string a kilometre long by one millimetre.



Now reducing CO2 by 1 millionth will cost Australia \$50 Billion dollars per year or \$4,550 per taxpayer per year.....BUT

China Alone increases its CO2 by Australia's amount every four months
